No sighting shots and no coaching allowed. *Service rifles only.*
Firing starts at 9am (check-in time closes at 8:45am).

Course of fire:

- Stage 1:** 200 yards' slow fire offhand, 10 shots in 10 minutes.
Stage 2: 200 yards sitting or kneeling from standing, 1 string of (mandatory reload) 10 shots in 60 seconds.
Stage 3: 300 yards prone from standing, 1 string of (mandatory reload) 10 shots in 70 seconds.
Stage 4: 600 yards' slow fire prone, 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.
Stages 1 and 2 will be fired in succession. Competitors must stand for the rapid fire stages.

Targets: decimal SR, SR-3 and MR
